## **AUTHORIZATION FOR DISPENSING MEDICATIONS**

Whenever possible, medications should be given at home. Every effort should be made to avoid dispensing medication during school hours. State la w ma ndates the foll owing informati on be given to the school before any medication or treatment can be administered or provided.

- 1. Written permission from the parent or guardian.
- 2. Written prescription from the doctor, including time of administration. This includes over the counter medication, such as Tylenol.
- 3. Parent or any adult must bring the medication to school. No child is allowed to bring medication to school.
- 4. Medication <u>must</u> be in a pharmacy labeled container. It cannot be given if it is not in a properly labeled bottle.
