D. Award Contract: Special Class Integrated Setting <u>Universal Pre-K Program</u>

**"WHEREAS,** during the 2023-24 school year, the East Syracuse Minoa Central School District (the "School District") issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP) for special class integrated setting universal pre-kindergarten program services for the 2024-25 school year pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 151-1.6 of the Commissioner's Regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, following the RFP process, the School District received and evaluated proposals from one vendor; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the recommendation of the School District's administration, the Board of Education wishes to award the contract for special class integrated setting universal pre-kindergarten program services to the responding vendor, Elmcrest Children's Center, Inc.;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board approves award of the contract for special class integrated setting universal pre-kindergarten program services pursuant to the RFP issued for the 2024-25 school year to Elmcrest Children's Center, Inc., and that the proposed terms of contract attached to the RFP are hereby approved and the Superintendent of Schools is authorized and directed to execute the same on behalf of the School District and to take all steps necessary to carry out the terms of such agreement."

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has had the opportunity to review the proposed SAP Agreement and MH/SSIS Agreement with Community Services, Inc. for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education of the School District resolves as follows:

- 1. The Board of Education hereby approves the SAP Agreement and MH/SSIS Agreement between the School District and Community Services, Inc. for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years.
- 2. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to execute the SAP Agreement and MH/SSIS Agreement in the forms approved by legal counsel, and take all actions necessary to carry out the terms of said agreements.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect July 15, 2024."
